







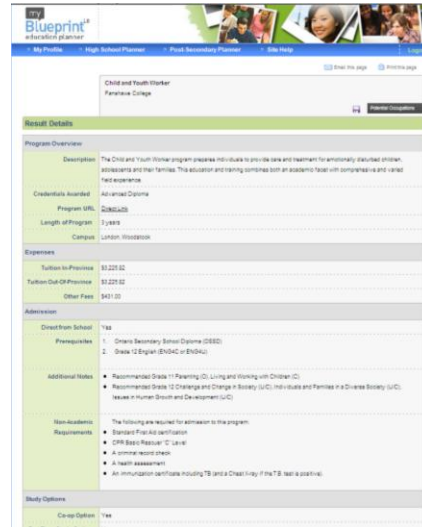
Instructions: MyBlueprint.ca for Post-Secondary Research

Step 1:	<p>Open Internet Explorer and navigate to www.myBlueprint.ca</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Enter the School Activation Key (password: timmins) and Click "Create an Account" to get started 																															
Step 2:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> You will be asked to enter your OEN (Ontario Education Number – 9 digit number on your student card & report cards) Press "Create New Account" and enter the required fields to personalize My Profile with your information and click "Save Profile & Start Using myBlueprint.ca". 																															
Step 3:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Click on the "Post Secondary Planner" on the blue menu bar at the top of the screen 																															
Step 4:	<p>Select Destination: Click on the path that you are interested in.</p>																															
Step 5:	<p>Specify your program</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Select province Select category & subcategory Type in the name of the program (fewer words are better to narrow the search) Click "search"
